For our Adjudicator this year we welcome Mr. Leonard White.

Mr. White is an actor of some considerable experience, having created the part of David King in the Festival of Britain production of Christopher Fry's "A Sleep of Prisoners." He also appeared in "Point of Departure" when he played Mathias and took over the leading role from Dirk Bogarde for several weeks.

He was a member of the 1946 Stratford-on-Avon Company. West-End roles include Malcolm to Michael Redgrave's Macbeth, Bezano in "He Who Gets Slapped," and Lodovico in "The White Devil" (Robert Helpmann season).

As adjudicator Mr. White's engagements have included the Gloucester Community Council Festival: Llandrindod Wells One Act Festival: Ammanford One Act Festival: North Wales Area Festival and the Yorkshire Final of the One Act Festival all of which have been part of the B.D.L. National Festivals.

With this wealth of experience we look forward this week to hearing Mr. White's adjudications and are sure to learn much.
