

'Mother Courage and her Children' takes place during the Thirty Years War; the play opens in 1624 and ends in 1636.

Mother Courage's wagon travels through Poland, Bavaria and Germany first with the Protestant forces then with the Catholics, following whichever army has the advantage at any particular time. For this is a war of religion and "God is merciful, and men are bribable, that's how His will is done on earth as it is in Heaven. Corruption is our only hope. As long as there's corruption, there'll be merciful judges and even the innocent may get off."
